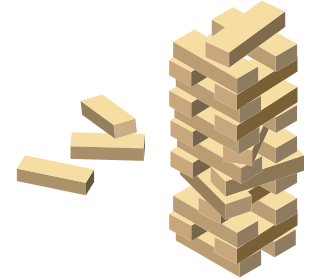

Directions

Think of a situation where someone would need to ask for consent from a friend. Then create your own Consent Comic by drawing and/or writing that scenario in the boxes on the reverse side.

Get creative! You get to choose who the characters are, what the situation is, how the question is asked, and how the question is answered. *Remember, we are in health class so anything your characters are doing should be healthy.*



Your consent comic must have all 6 Building Blocks of Consent present.

Make sure:

- ✓ Your characters are the **appropriate age** to be making the decision.
- ✓ They are in an **equal or shared power** relationship.
- ✓ If you decide that the character responds with a **yes**, make sure it is **enthusiastic and clear**.
- ✓ The person's response must be **freely given**, meaning they aren't pressured or forced.
- ✓ Everyone involved must clearly **understand** what it is they are consenting to.
- ✓ Each character must know that they can change their mind if they want to, because consent is always **reversible**.
